`Rishi is a young, sustainable clothing brand that creates clothing using upcycling techniques. The designers of the brand consider it their duty to look for new solutions which make fashion industry more environmentally friendly and follow circular policy in the clothing production process. The `Rishi team appeals to purchase clothes without expiration date and encourages a conscious attitude to consumption of things. In production of its collections `Rishi uses previously used denim and cotton, as well as textile leftovers from clothing manufacturing and sewing schools.
